

Explanatory Notes on Main Statistical Indicators

Percentage of Graduates in Primary Schools Entering Junior Secondary Schools

refers to the proportion of school-age students in junior secondary schools (regular junior secondary schools and vocational junior secondary schools) to the total number of junior school-age students.

Percentage of School-age Children Enrolled

refers to the proportion of children enrolled at primary schools to the total number of primary school-age children (including retarded children, but excluding blind, deaf and mute children). The formula is:

$$\text{Percentage of School-age Children Enrolled} = \frac{\text{Total Primary School-age Children at School}}{\text{Total Primary School-age Children}} \times 100\%$$

Network Education

refers to the net education implemented by modern distance education selected institute approved by the Ministry of Education, who recruit the regular and adult undergraduate students and junior college students base on Internet to give high level education.
